In July 2019, four members of the Badillo family from Hidalgo state, Mexico, were forced to leave their homes because of their Protestant faith, and despite numerous appeals to various authorities, they still have been unable to return home. Let us pray that God would soften the hearts of individuals at all levels of the Mexican government to respond to these appeals.

Give thanks that CSW's "Let her be heard" report, published in March, on the experiences of indigenous religious minority women in Mexico, has been widely read. Let us pray that policymakers would take concrete action to ensure the rights of these women are protected.
