

PRAYER FOCUS

CSW Prayer Focus at Easter

With the resurrection of Jesus on the first Easter Sunday, Christ won the victory over death and darkness - paving the way for everyone to be reconciled and restored. With this confidence CSW ask us to join them in praying for:

Christian communities around the world who are prevented from attending Easter services, or who are unable to celebrate freely and safely. May they be filled with the joy of the resurrection and strengthened with hope for change;

that Christians imprisoned for their faith would know the close presence of their risen Lord. Pray too for the release of everyone unjustly imprisoned in connection with their religion or belief.

For the safety and protection of faith communities in countries like Nigeria, who are particularly at risk of attacks during this Easter season.

For healing and restoration for the survivors of previous Easter attacks, and for those whose loved ones were killed. We think especially of Sri Lanka in 2019, and Pakistan in 2015 and 2016.

Gaza Appeal: Methodists urged to donate (and pray)

The Methodist Church in Britain has launched an appeal to support the emergency work being carried out in Gaza by the Methodist Liaison Office's partners. The partners' work focuses on helping civilians in Gaza with medical, dental and mental health issues and offering them financial support. Speaking about the war in the Gaza Strip, the President and Vice-President of Conference expressed their deep horror at the physical and psychological impact the continued impact violence is having on families:

"The scale of the destruction and tragic loss of life in so short a space of time is incomparable to any other conflict in recent times. We grieve for all lives lost on October 7th and in the subsequent fighting. There is no justification for such widespread killing of tens of thousands of innocent people and we are gravely concerned for the entire population of the Gaza Strip."

Methodists are being asked to donate to the Methodist Church World Mission Fund via JustGiving (www.donate.justgiving.com) - adding "GAZA APPEAL" at the end of the online form.

Donations can also be made here at church over the next few Sundays in the bowl marked "Gaza Appeal", and this will be forwarded to the World mission Fund.
